This approval relates to the use of Lentagran WP as an agricultural herbicide for the control of annual dicot weeds including black nightshade, cleavers, fat-hen, fumitory, groundsel.

Resistance Management:

Pesticides of different chemical groups or alternative control measures should be included in the planned anti-resistance strategy. This product should be used in conjunction with other products from different cross-resistant groups [different mode of action, HRAC group] with satisfactory efficacy against the target.

Lentagran WP contains Pyridate classed HRAC C3.
